
Online training of M&E and park managers was organized in April 2023 and witnessed the participation of 20 persons.

# **Main Activities and Results in** 2023

- Agronomic, Agro-Ecological and Farming Systems Innovations
- Genetic Innovations (Varieties, Hybrids and Genotypes) and New Crops
- Post harvest technologies
- Digital Tools, Mechanization and Other Innovations

38 open field days and guide visited organized to showcase technologies under demonstration in the parks; these activities witnessed the participation of at least 2 500 stakeholders including 36% of women.
